## Arts & Crafts Festival

2010, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**COST:** \$40 per space, approximately 10 x 10 feet outdoors (will fit a canopy). You may reserve one or two spaces.

**RAIN:** In the event of inclement weather, the festival will be held in the Nazareth Area High School (E. Center St.). To accommodate every reserved crafter, the spaces will not be as large indoors. The decision to move may not be made until 7 a.m. that morning. A message will be left on the museum answering machine (610-759-5070) by 7 a.m. if the weather is questionable. Only crafters with a space reserved in advance will be accommodated at the indoor location.

**BRING:** Whatever you will need for your display. We give you the space, you supply the rest: tables, display materials, canopy, electrical cords, chairs, people to help you carry and set up, etc. Water is available on the premises, but not at a specific space. Electricity may be available by advance arrangement, and at an additional cost.

**SPACE:** Your space will be assigned in advance. You will receive notice of your space number toward the end of May. We will make every effort to accommodate requests for placement of spaces, but we cannot guarantee a specific location.

**SET UP:** Set up begins at 7 a.m. on Saturday, June 12. Take-down should not begin before 3 p.m.

**REFUNDS:** No refunds are given for cancellations after June 5, 2010.

## More Information about the Arts & Crafts Festival

1. **All items sold must be handcrafted.** They need not be made by you, but they must be handmade by someone. This is not a juried show, and we have no limits on the number of crafters who make the same thing. Keep this in mind as you plan your display. Make it attractive and appealing so that people will want to stop at your booth.
2. **Crafters cannot compete with food sellers.** Prepared foods which can be eaten immediately are generally not allowed for sale at a craft booth. If you have a question about this, check with the show coordinator at (610)759-5070 or email [adminasst@moravianhistoricalsociety.org](mailto:adminasst@moravianhistoricalsociety.org).
3. **Please keep in mind that this is an outdoor show, held on a grassy lawn.** Every effort is made to accommodate your needs for sun, shade, place to set up a canopy, etc. If your space is unsuitable when you arrive, someone will try to assign you a more suitable space. Just come to the office of the Whitefield House.
4. The show's organizers cannot control the weather, no matter how hard we try. **Be sure to pack plastic tarps, sides of your canopy, or other emergency measures in case of an unexpected shower.** The organizers are not responsible for damage to your merchandise.
5. **Parking is limited to on-street parking.** There is no parking lot, either for crafters or for customers. You may **NOT** park on the Whitefield House lawn. Please remember to park as far away as possible, to allow room for your customers to park.
6. **You may not drive on the grass.** There is an area where you can drive your car while you unload, but your car must be moved during the open hours of the festival. You can bring your car into the same area when packing up. Security officers will show you where you can park to load and unload.
7. **Items considered to be offensive in sexual, racial, ethnic, or other terms may be forbidden by the organizers to be sold.** Refusal to withdraw the items may result in the crafter being expelled from the property with no refund.
8. **Nothing may be nailed, stapled, or attached to any building, tree, or anything on the property** that does not belong to you. See the office if you have questions or problems.
